STAY

EAT & DRINK

Gourmet French food meets local produce on an island that's known for its locally-grown fruits and vegetables and its abundance of seafood. Think: classic French dishes with a tropical twist. Oh, and some of the most delicious wine you'll taste outside of France.

Enjoy an AU\$50 dining credit to use at the decadent La Terrasse Restaurant with your stay at Hilton Nouméa. Overlook the waters of Anse Vata Bay as you feast on tasty local staples with a modern twist like seared tuna with polenta, deer tartar with capers and parmesan cheese and beef rossini.

The region's staple dish is a combination of chicken, lobster or fish mixed with yams, bananas, sweet potatoes and coconut milk and wrapped in a banana leaf. Bougna-as the locals call it-can be found steaming on hot stones roadside or at local restaurants. Don't look past your nightly buffet dinner inclusion at Escapade Restaurant that'll feature more delicious local staples made with locallysourced produce.

Local tip: If the striking Isle of Pines is on your New Caledonia itinerary, sample the forest-dwelling snails, considered a delicacy by the locals who farm them.

When you're surrounded by a UNESCO World Heritage-listed lagoon, it's a must to enjoy a tipple with a backdrop of gently lapping waves and turquoise ripples. Head to Nouméa's floating Pop Light - one of New Caledonia's hottest bars positioned on stilts above the ocean. Or watch the waves from Code Bar, at Hilton Nouméa's neighbouring Nouvata Hotel, where vou'll enjoy two welcome house wines or local beers with your stay.

EXPLORE

The islands of New Caledonia epitomise natural beauty with their pristine sands, untouched waters and colourful sea life.
